

SINGLE-VEHICLE CRASHES ARE PREVENTABLE!

In a five-year study of fatal traffic-related cases, it was determined that 66 of the 151 fatal law enforcement vehicle crashes were single-vehicle crashes.

That is 44% of all fatal vehicle crashes.

The most common scenario involved an officer responding to a call for service at night, losing control of the police vehicle and impacting with a fixed object.



53% of the officers who died in single-vehicle crashes were NOT wearing their seat belt!
