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VALOR helps prevent violence against law enforcement officers and ensures officer resilience and survivability following violent encounters during the course of their duties. VALOR responds to the precipitous increase in ambush-style assaults that have taken the lives of many law enforcement officers.

VALOR is designed to be a comprehensive effort that will include classroom and web-based training, research, and resources for sworn state, local, and tribal law enforcement officers.

The VALOR Training covers topics including:

- How to anticipate and survive a violent encounter
- Techniques for identifying concealed weapons and/or armed gunmen
- High-risk tactical considerations
- Specific threat groups and violent criminals
