

Circumstances of Fatal Shootings:
Mid-year 2012

Of the 19 firearms-related fatalities, six officers were killed in ambush attacks, the most of any circumstance of fatal shootings for 2012. Three officers were killed feloniously during traffic stops, which is the same total from this time last year.
