




## Officers Killed While Alone

In a Memorial Fund study of all line of duty death cases between 2010 and 2014, 132 cases involved officers who were attacked and killed after being dispatched to a call for service or while conducting self-initiated actions such as traffic stops. The most frequent reason an officer was alone when they were assaulted and killed is because they were dispatched to a call alone.

## Circumstances Where an Officer Was Alone When Killed



Seven officers were killed after responding to a call and not waiting for back up to arrive before taking action. Five were killed while engaged in a foot pursuit and four were killed while canvassing an area for a suspect.
