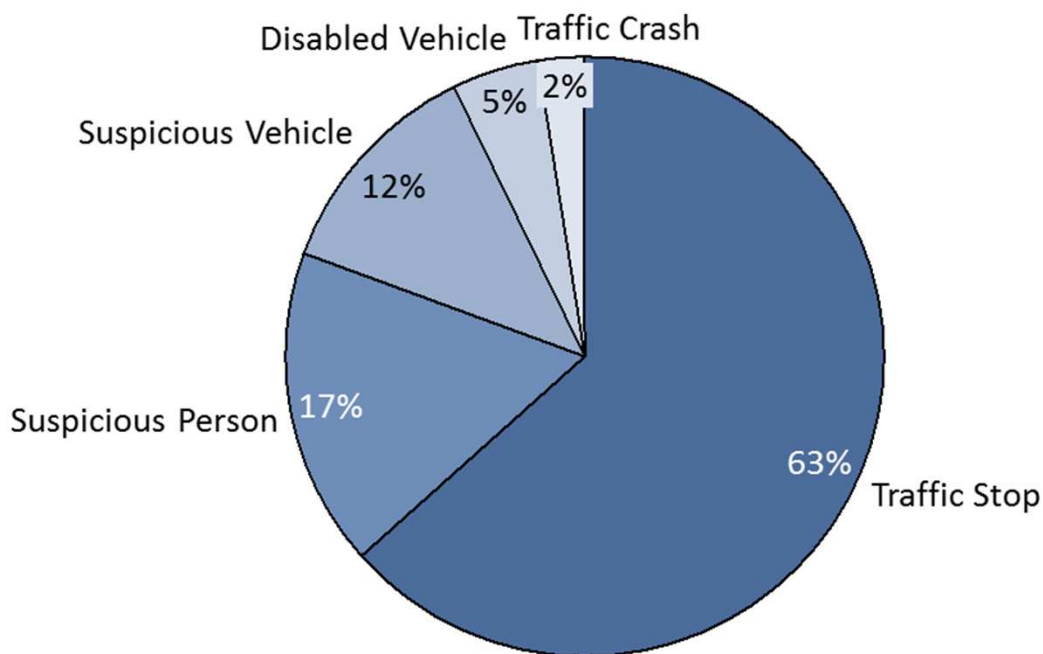

Self-Initiated Activities That Resulted in Line of Duty Death

In a Memorial Fund study of all line of duty death cases between 2010 and 2014, 41 cases involved officers conducting self-initiated actions such as traffic stops or suspicious person investigations. Among those cases, “Traffic Stops” were the most frequent type of self-initiated activity that ended in an officer being killed by a suspect.
