



## RECOGNITION OPPORTUNITIES

### Donor Kiosk – \$999 and Below

Donors will have their names listed in a computer kiosk that will be prominently featured in the Museum facility.

### Thin Blue Line - \$1,000

Donors will have the opportunity to include their name in the *Thin Blue Line* that will run through the panels of the Glass Bridge in the Museum. This beautiful glass bridge will connect the east and west mezzanine levels and will overlook the Main Concourse of the Museum.

### Theater Seat - \$10,000

Donors will have the opportunity to name one of more than 100 Theater Seats in the Museum Theater where the introductory film will be viewed by all visitors.

### Risers - \$25,000

Donors will have the opportunity to name one of eight risers in the Museum. Five of the risers are in the Cop Critique Theater and three are in the Judgment Simulator exhibition.

### Cast Figures - \$50,000

Donors will have the opportunity to name one of the five cast figures displayed in the Museum. These figures are life sized and would be featured in the SWAT and K-9 exhibition, as well as in the Bomb Squad exhibition.

### Major Donor Wall - \$100,000 and Above

All donors at the \$100,000 and above level will have their names inscribed on a prominent and dramatic wall space along the Glass Bridge overlooking the main exhibit floor. Donors will be listed by giving levels. Donors at this level who commit prior to the Museum groundbreaking ceremony, scheduled for October 2010, will receive special recognition.

### Agency Kiosks - \$250,000

Donors will have the opportunity to name one of two computer kiosks that contain information about every federal, state and municipal and county law enforcement agency in the United States.

### Exhibit Sponsorships - \$1,000,000 and Above
